### **NGT MOTORSPORT FILLS FRONT OF THE GRID AT NEW JERSEY MOTORSPORTS PARK**

MILLEVILLE, NJ June 26 – NGT Motorsport once again displayed their incredible speed and confidence on the track at New Jersey Motorsports Park for the Mazda Motorsports Festival of Speed presented by VisitFlorida.com. Now the drivers of NGT must keep the pressure on as they occupy the front of the Gold Cup Class starting grid for Round 5 of the Patrón GT3 Challenge by Yokohama.

With two full days of testing and practice under their belts, the drivers of NGT Motorsport were confident in their cars and on the track. In the first Practice Session on Friday, June 25<sup>th</sup>, #26 Henrique Cisneros, #29 Eduardo Cisneros and #25 Andres Cisneros, all showed their skills and determination, posting fast laps in the top 6 in class. The second Practice Session was just as successful for the team, with #24 Carlos Eduardo claiming the fastest lap of the session, and #29 Eduardo Cisneros once again in the top 5 of the Gold Cup Class.

“This track is great,” said Henrique. “The car has been fantastic and the team has done a great job setting it up.” Eduardo agreed, saying, “We have the best team in the Patrón GT3 Challenge by Yokohama. NGT is committed to providing us with the best cars and the most advanced equipment. Our job as drivers is to get out on the track and put their hard work to good use, putting the cars at the front of the grid.”

And when Qualifying began, there was no question that the NGT Motorsport team intended to do just that. #26 Henrique Cisneros posted his fastest time on lap 4 with an impressive 1:25.189, just 3-tenths of a second off the pole sitter, putting him in second position in the Gold Cup Class. Teammate #24 Carlos Eduardo did his best to track his teammate down, but to no avail; with a fast lap of 1:25.237, only 4-tenths of a second separate the two drivers, and gave Carlos the third fastest lap in Qualifying.

The second part of the NGT Motorsport team also had a great Qualifying run. #29 Eduardo Cisneros posted his 1:26.629 on lap 5, just after teammate #25 Andres Cisneros posted a 1:27.917 on lap 3, giving all the NGT drivers qualifying times in the top 7 positions in class. Says Andres, “This season has been tremendous for us as a team, and for me as a driver. My teammates and I share data, learn from one another, and continue to be a dominate force on the track.” And it’s clear that NGT Motorsport will continue to be a strong force in the Patrón GT3 Challenge as they lead the Gold Cup Class in championship points.

Rounds 5 & 6 of the Patrón GT3 Challenge by Yokohama continue at New Jersey Motorsports Park as part of the Mazda Motorsports Festival of Speed presented by VisitFlorida.com. Round 5 will begin today, June 26<sup>th</sup> at 4:10pm EST, with Round 6 scheduled for tomorrow, Sunday, June 27<sup>th</sup> at 11:10am EST.
